

Massachusetts State Grange Educational Aid Fund
Part-Time Scholarship Application

Scholarships are available for Grange members who are enrolled part-time in degree-granting programs. A part-time undergraduate student is defined as one enrolled in up to 11 credit hours per semester. Part-time graduate student definitions vary by college/university. Part-time scholarships are awarded at 50% of the full-time scholarship amount as determined by the Trustees of the Educational Aid Fund at the annual July meeting. Applications may be submitted at any time and will be acted upon at the next meeting of the Trustees.

Students who apply for a Part-Time Scholarship are eligible to apply for the Thomas F. Severance Award for Outstanding Grange Service and the Harry Lucas Community Service Excellence Award. An additional application form is required for each of these awards. Applicants for these awards are reviewed annually in July. Due to the limited number of these awards given annually, students applying for a Part-Time Scholarship at another time of the year will have their applications for the Severance and Lucas awards reviewed in July.

Applicants must supply the following with this application form:

- Evidence of enrollment in a degree-granting program or college credit-bearing course (such as an acceptance letter or schedule for upcoming semester/term)
- Proof of payment for the current/upcoming term (such as a billing statement from the college showing payment or other receipt)
- Most recent academic transcript (high school or college) showing proof of high school graduation or prior enrollment in a college or university

Applicants will be notified of the status of their application following the next meeting of the Trustees of the Fund.
